Brighton's partnership with R.C.C. has been an amazing success! Together we have designed a program where Brighton students can earn transferable university credits while on our campus. Our goal is to allow Brighton students to earn a two year transferable college degree by the time they graduate from our High School. We started this program in January 2009 with a handful of High School students and ended last week with 29 students participating from grades 8 thru 12. Our students continue to amaze everyone involved!

## Volunteer Policy

Brighton Academy believes family involvement is an essential part of a child's education and volunteer hours are required from all Brighton families. Since our fundraising is necessary all Brighton families are required to participate in both our Jog-a-thon and our auction, meeting all individual goals set.

- A minimum of 5 volunteer hours per month per family is required. (We will amortize any large number of hours spent on a single event.)
- All parents/guardians must attend 2 parent meetings per year.
- Family participation is required in our two major Brighton fundraisers: the Auction in fall and the Jog-a-thon in spring. Families must meet the goals set in each of these fundraisers

All volunteering must be pre-arranged and documented through the office. Families who do not meet the 5 hour per month volunteer requirement will be charged a \$45.00 per month fee. Families who do not fulfill the fund raising requirement may be charged an additional \$250 annually.

## Tuition Billing:

Our tuition costs will remain the same next year. Please remember our tuition is an annual rate billed in 10 monthly courtesy installments. Tuition is due the 1st of each month with a 10 day grace period, then late fees apply.

## RESTRICTED ITEMS FROM HOME
