BRIGHTON ACADEMY DRESS CODE 2019/2020

Brighton Academy believes that learning about appropriate dress is an important part of a student's education and personal growth. An awareness of dressing for occasions and events will prepare students for success in their chosen careers. For this reason, Brighton Academy maintains a conservative dress code for all grade levels. This may not include all present and future clothing styles.

HEAD:

- No facial piercings or exposed body piercings are allowed. Only girls are allowed ear piercings, but no excessive jewelry or piercings.
- No tattoos, heavy make-up or unconventional hair colors or styles.
- Hair must be neat and well groomed. Boys hair must be cut above the ears and collar or fastened at the nape of the neck.
- No hats or hoodies worn in class.

ELECTRONICS:

- GRADES 9-12 NO CELLPHONE OR IPOD USE DURING CLASS!
- GRADES K-8 NO CELLPHONES USE DURING SCHOOL HOURS!

UPPER GARMENTS:

- Proper under garments must be worn at all times.
- NO crop tops, tube tops, halters and spaghetti straps (anything less than 2 inches is considered a spaghetti strap.) Strapless dresses without jackets are unacceptable.
- The display of cleavage is unacceptable. Low cut blouses, tops, sweaters, etc. with plunging necklines are not allowed.
- All garments must be long enough to clearly overlap the beltline at all times even when moving or seated.
- No skin tight or form fitting tops.

LOWER GARMENTS:

- Dresses, skirts and shorts must be at least mid-thigh or below in length.
- Leggings, tights, spandex or yoga pants may only be worn under a dress, skirt or shorts.
- Undergarments and buttock must be entirely covered even when sitting.
- Footwear must be worn at all times.
- No wheeled shoes or skates.
- No skate boards, scooters or bicycles can be ridden on campus.
